

Colwall Cricket Club 2021 - Proposed Membership Subscription Categories

Junior Membership

Incorporates Family Membership for both parents (Social Membership, no voting rights).

>>> Family Membership	1 child	£40
	Additional Siblings	£30 (2nd child), £20 (3rd child), £10 (4th child)

A junior is anyone who is not yet 18 on 1st May of the year in question. Anyone not 18 must complete the Junior Membership form, and will be administered by the Junior section / management for the whole year, regardless of whether they turn 18 during the season after 1st May. If a young player has reached his 18th birthday by 1st May, they should be re-directed to the club's Full Membership form (since they have transitioned to a 'Senior').

Senior Membership

Full Membership

>>> Full Membership (includes voting rights)		£60
Joint Full Membership (just 1 vote)		£75

*There will be a box to tick on the form to indicate 'Player'.
All players must be Full Members*

Social Membership

>>> Social Membership (no voting rights)		£30
Joint Social Membership (no voting rights)		£40

Anyone wishing to have voting rights will need to subscribe as an individual Full Member

Background

2020 posed various challenges for the committee when it came to laying on certain events and prioritising limited spaces to Members. For example, the screening of the live VKO final where we were only allowed to accommodate a limited number of attendees to conform to Covid guidelines. When members requested tickets for themselves and their spouses / partners, it raised questions as to whether partners who aren't paid up Members should be allocated a ticket in favour of a Social Member for example. This is the reason that from 2021 we will be offering the Joint Membership categories above, so that a clear 'pecking order' will be defined for the next time we are faced with laying on events or transport etc for limited numbers.

In addition, from 2021, we would like to ensure that when Members subscribe, that they select the Full or Social Membership they require so that we can be sure the Membership database correctly reflects the voting rights of our Members. Too much guesswork has taken place in previous years in allocating Non-Playing and Social Membership categories to individuals. This will mean a drive to ensure everyone completes the Membership Forms next year.
